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## Direct Intra-Venous (DIV) Ozone Therapy

1. What is Direct Intra-Venous Therapy?

ANSWER: Is ozone given to the body through the vein(s) of the arm(s).

2. What is ozone?

ANSWER: Is oxygen (O<sub>2</sub>) with an extra oxygen (O<sub>3</sub>) molecule on it.

3. What is DIV Ozone used for?

ANSWER: To treat a myriad of symptoms and complaints including, but not limited to:

- a. Infectious disease- (e.g. tick-borne disease, yeast, bacteria, viral and parasite infections, hepatitis
- b. Cardiovascular disease- lack of oxygen (ischemia), atherosclerosis
- c. Joint and muscle pain- fibromyalgia, complex regional pain syndrome, other chronic pain syndromes
- d. Nervous system problems- shingles, neuropathy, ALS,
- e. Auto-immune disease- thyroiditis, SLE, rheumatoid arthritis, Sjogren's
- f. Endocrine disease- thyroid nodules, diabetes mellitus, Type 1,

4. What is involved in giving DIV Ozone Therapy?

ANSWER: The general steps (not specific as the steps are tailored to the individual) are:

- a. Daily consumption of ½ of your body weight in ounces, e.g. wt.= 180 lbs., sip 90 oz. of water throughout the day.
- b. Daily consumption of Vitamin C in the form of Ascorbic Acid (crystals) or liposomal Vitamin C up to 10 grams (10,000 mg) a day as tolerated.
- c. Daily consumption of pro-biotics (Klaire Labs Thera-Biotic Complete Powder, Zana Juice).
- d. A commitment to come to our office for treatment three (3) days a week minimum or per recommendations of Dr. Dillard.
- e. Use light weights or warm compresses to easily identify veins and administer ozone.
- f. Ability to lay flat on the examination table to receive ozone as the gas is evenly distributed throughout the body.
- g. DIV ozone is given in the vein over a time of 2-15 minutes based on the comfort of your veins.
- h. The understanding that there is no set number of treatments for successful resolution of symptoms and/or conditions.

- i. No maintenance treatment is required.
5. Are there any adverse interactions with medications and/or supplements?

ANSWER: No.

6. Are there any contra-indications for receiving DIV Ozone Therapy?

ANSWER: Yes. Pregnancy.

7. Have patients had to stop DIV Ozone Therapy for any reason?

ANSWER: Yes. Seven (7) patients over the course of a 21-year research study were withdrawn from the study due to developing a rash for unexplained reasons.

8. Are there any research studies on DIV Ozone Therapy?

10. Can't I get an air embolism from injecting air in the vein?

ANSWER: DIV Ozone Therapy is not air. Ozone is medical grade oxygen converted to ozone with a properly calibrated Ozonator. Secondly, it requires over 400 ml of air to be injected into one's vein to develop an air embolism. We are using at most 240 ml of ozone, and in most cases 60 ml of ozone.

11. Will I feel anything during the DIV Ozone Therapy?

ANSWER: It depends on each person. Many people do not feel anything other than the insertion of the pigtail catheter. Others may feel some burning in the vein by which we will decrease the rate at which the ozone is administered, the amount of ozone and/or the concentration of the ozone given.

Some people experience the urge to cough or slight tightness in the chest. Do not cough, including taking deep coughs or deep breaths. In some instances, we will administer 2-3 LPM oxygen through the nose for a few minutes to help the symptoms to pass.

12. Will I feel anything after I leave the office after receiving DIV Ozone Therapy?

ANSWER: In most cases, No.

If you have poor water intake, do not take Vitamin C and pro-biotics as recommended you are at increased risk of experiencing a Herxheimer Reaction; which is the release of toxins from the organisms and/or toxins from the body, as it should be after DIV Ozone Therapy. This reaction, which you will most likely avoid if follow the pre-treatment instructions, will go away in a few days.

*The following is added for clarification:* If you experience, sweating, lightheadedness, chest pain, chest tightness, shortness of breath, heartburn, etc. hours to days after the treatment you most likely having a cardiac event unrelated to the DIV Ozone Therapy and need to call 911 and be taken to the nearest emergency room for evaluation.

13. Are there any special pre-cautions I must take after I receive my DIV Ozone Therapy?

ANSWER: No. You may resume your normal activities immediately after treatment as tolerated.

14. How often can I receive DIV Ozone Therapy?

ANSWER: As often as Dr. Dillard recommends. The range in frequency of treatment is from 3/week to 3/day, six days a week.

15. What is the price for DIV Ozone Therapy (and Intra-Abdominal Ozone Therapy/IAOT)?

ANSWER: The price list is as follows:

- a. \$125/injection
- b. \$83/injection
  - a. if you use our DIV-Discount Package (\$1,000; 10 injections with 2 given for free)

16. Is DIV Ozone Therapy included in my Direct Wellness Care (DWC) package?
